How much does it Cost? The cost for the weekend \$124. A \$50 deposit is due by Wed, Jan 19th. The balance is due on the date of the trip. This cost includes transportation, lodging, meals at the retreat site, and activities. It is the policy of Sunrise Student Ministry that no student be excluded from an activity because of cost. How do I sign up? By turning in your deposit and permission slip to Matt, Christina, Janet or Beth you reserve a spot on the retreat. You must complete the permission form and an Emergency Contact and Health Information form. If you do not have an Emergency Contact and Health Information form, log onto www.sunrisesstudents.org and print the form from the link on the contact page. No student will be allowed to go on the trip without the permission form and the health form. You also must be paid in full to attend the trip.

What should I bring? You will need to bring money for food on the way up and the way back (\$10 total). You will also need a towel, pillow, toiletries (soap etc), swimsuit, clothes for outside/snow activity (may get dirty), Bible and pen. You do not need music devices or other electronics.
